

- Have an intentional gospel conversation at least once a month
- Befriend an unchurched person and invite them to church
- Pray for the Pastor daily; Always speak words of encouragement
- Support all worship services and church activities with my attendance

### THE CHURCH

- Encourage individuals and families in reaching their goals
- Create an intentional time of prayer before worship services begin
- Greet all guests with a smile and warm words
- Invite guests to sit with me and my family
- Develop a strategy to reach inactive church members
- Develop a strategy to reach unchurched in the community

a living sacrifice that God will use to experience a true and lasting revival. **SO, FAN THE FLAMES OF REVIVAL! -- Tony**




## Associational, News, Events, Information





If your church is incorporated, please remember that *Annual Reports for Churches and Charitable Organizations* are due at the State of Tennessee by April 1. These reports update or confirm an entity with the Tennessee Department of State, and are required to maintain "active status" so a business or church can legally operate in the state. In order to complete your yearly filing, you need your *User Account Login Information and Control Number*. The *Annual Corporation Filing* can be completed online at <https://tncab.tnsos.gov/>

A new question was asked pertaining to an *NAICS* code on the renewal filing for this year. The *NAICS* is a unique classification code for economic activity and comparisons. It is our understanding there was no change in the religious organization class code.




