Purpose of Position:

Additionally, the Youth and Recreation Pastor will develop and oversee the recreation ministry at FBC.

Key Responsibilities:

Spiritual Leadership:

- Lead regular youth group meetings, Bible studies, and discipleship programs.
- Develop and implement a yearly calendar of youth events, camps, retreats, mission trips, and outreach initiatives.
- Promote a culture of prayer, worship, and biblical study among youth, encouraging their individual spiritual growth.

Discipleship and Mentorship:

- Must pass a background check in accordance with church policy.
